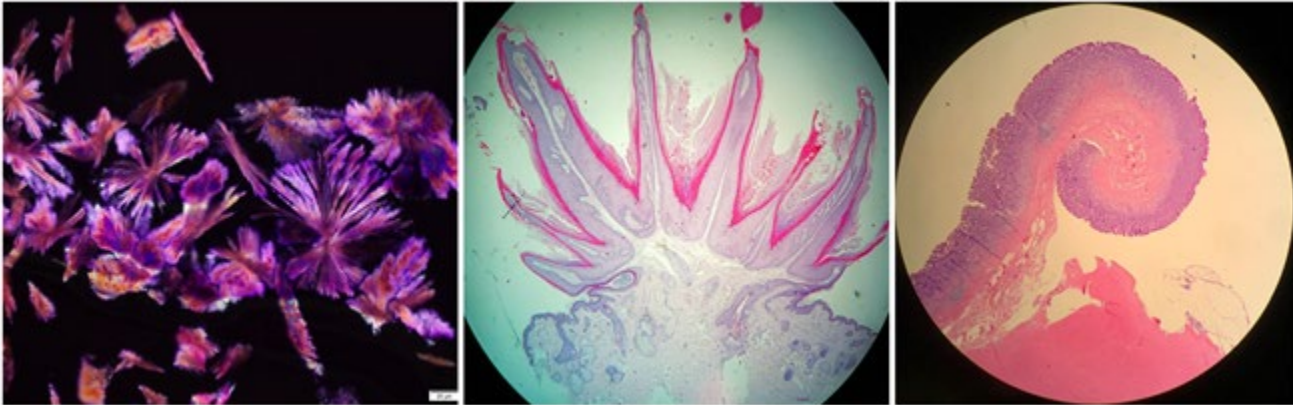


****IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING FUTURE “FUN FRIDAY” EMAILS****

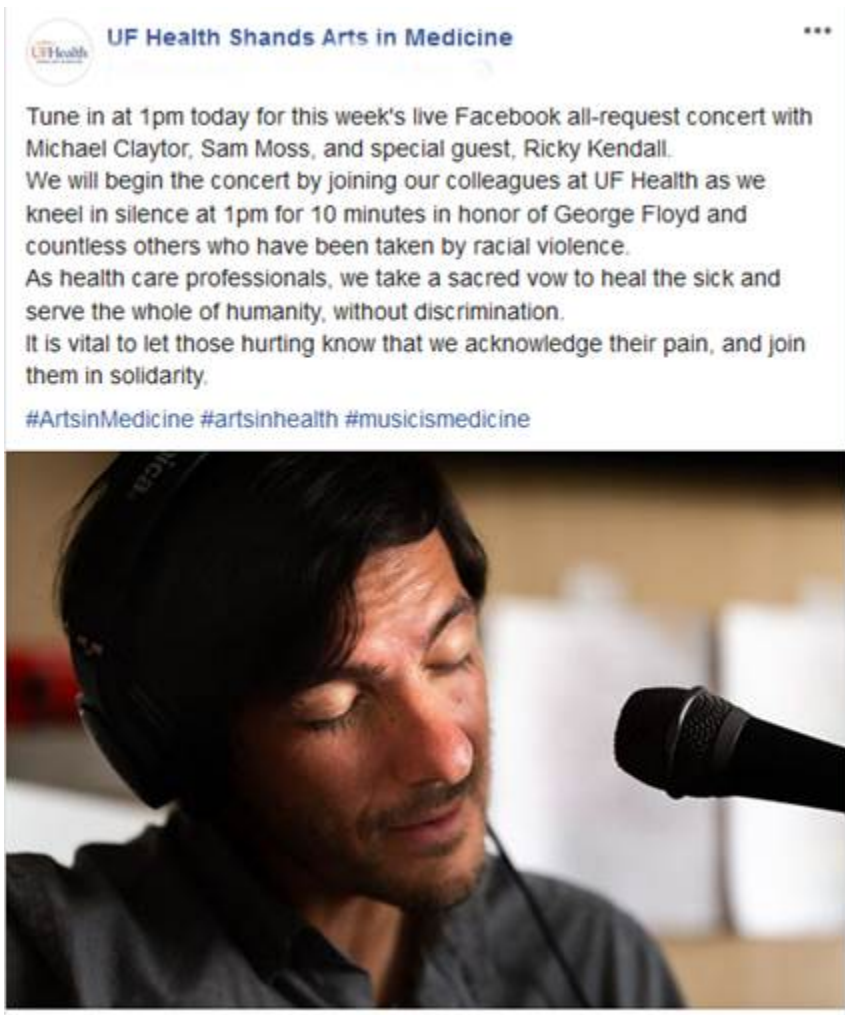

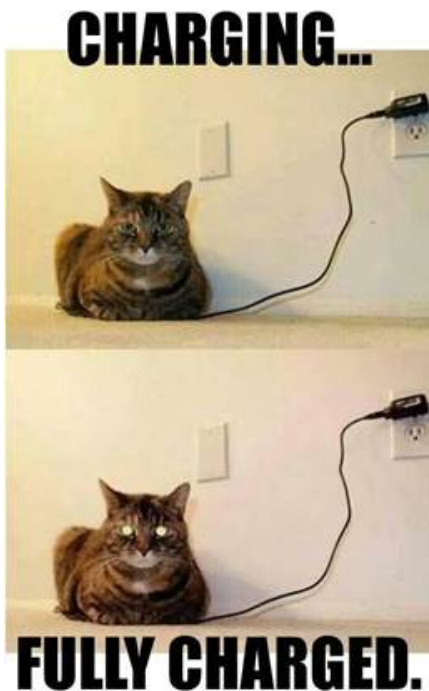
